## **Glossary**

active volcano - volcano that erupts occasionally

ash – powder coming out of a volcano

barren – not good enough to produce crops

clinker - rough stony material

concrete – building material made by mixing cement with sand, etc and water

cone - solid body that narrows to a pointfrom a circular flat base crater - hole in the top of a volcano

diversion (to divert) – action of turning sth aside or changing its direction

dormant volcano – a volcano that is temporarily inactive, neither active nor extinct

eruption (to erupt) – outbreak of a volcano

evacuation, to evacuate – removal of people from a place of danger to a safer place

extinct volcano – a volcano that is no longer active

fertile - able to produce much

to gush out – to flow or pour out suddenly

mud – soft wet earth

slope - area of rising or falling ground

steam cloud - a cloud consisting of invisible gas into which water is changed by boiling

vent - opening that allows gas, liquid, etc to pass out of or into a confined space
